Market Details:

• Location: Putnam County Courthouse – 410 St Johns Ave, Palatka, FL 32177

• **Operating Hours:** 1st & 3rd Saturdays, 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM (only ONE Market in December, this will be on December 6th)

• **Season:** September – May

Vendor Categories:

• Farmer Vendors: Locally grown fruits and vegetables

• General Vendors: Handcrafted goods such as jewelry, pottery, and textiles

• Food Vendors: Prepared foods, baked goods, and beverages

Vendor Guidelines:

- **Product Requirements:** All products must be locally produced or handcrafted.
- **Licensing:** Vendors must possess all necessary licenses and permits as required by local and state regulations.
- **Insurance:** Food Vendors are required to carry liability insurance and provide a Certificate of Liability Insurance.
- Setup and Teardown:
 - o Designated vendor parking is available near the market area.
 - Vendors may begin setup at 7:00 AM 8:30, vehicles must be moved afterward. All vendors may begin vacating the premises starting at 2:00pm and must be complete by 3:00 PM.
 - Food Trucks, those selling from trailers, and others set up in the parking lot
 <u>MUST</u> arrive prior to 8:30am. Late arrivals will not be allowed to move into
 their designated area.
 - o No vehicle movement is allowed in the market area during open hours.
- Farmer & General Vendors: 10' x 10' booth space.
- Electricity Access: Is not provided. Vendors must plan accordingly.
- On-Site Assistance:
 - A market coordinator will be present at the Visit Palatka booth to assist vendors throughout the day.
- Booth Assignments:

- o Booth locations are assigned by market management based on vendor category, application order, and space availability.
- o A vendor layout map will be shared prior to each market day.
- **Booth Maintenance:** Vendors are responsible for keeping their booths clean and disposing of trash properly.

Application Process:

- 1. **Complete the Vendor Application Form:** Available upon request via email at info@visitpalatka.com or through our website: Farmers Market Visit Palatka
- 2. Submit Required Documents:
 - o Completed Vendor Application Form
 - o Certificate of Liability Insurance
- 3. **Review and Approval:** Applications will be reviewed, and an approval notification will be sent via email.

Fees:

- **Application Fee:** \$10 (non-refundable)
- Farmer & General Vendor Booth Fee: \$30 per market day per booth
- **Food Vendor:** \$75 per market day
- Non-Profit Organizations & Political Groups: \$15 per market day per booth

Payment Methods:

- Online Payment: via Invoice that will be sent to provided email
- Checks payable to Visit Palatka

Additional Information:

- Weather Policy: The market operates rain or shine. In cases of severe weather, cancellations will be communicated via email and social media.
- Code of Conduct: All vendors are expected to conduct themselves professionally and courteously.
- Compliance: Vendors must comply with all market rules and local regulations. Non-compliance may result in dismissal from the market.
